

Thrive is a comprehensive approach to health and rights that places the woman, adolescent or child at the centre and unlocks her access to the full spectrum of interventions needed throughout her lifecycle to reach her full potential.

Thrive builds on current annual investments of \$1 billion and calls for an additional investment of \$400 million year over year to fill critical gaps.



Investment in women and children's health has a potential return of \$15 CAD for every dollar spent.



Every \$1 spent on contraceptive services in developing regions saves \$2.20 in maternal and newborn healthcare
